

Social Impacts and Community Facilities

Why is this important?

Social resources include a variety of factors that may affect quality of life. The East Corridor considered:

- Housing
- Population and households
- Public services and community organizations
- Emergency services
- Neighborhood character and cohesion
- Current health conditions

Potential Impacts

- Acquisition of six residential properties including seven associated relocations.
- No impacts to community facilities (e.g. schools, libraries, recreation centers, etc.).
- Benefit from improved transit system and decreased congestion.

Proposed Mitigation

- Provide acquisition and relocation assistance to impacted properties consistent with the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act (Uniform Act) of 1970, as amended.
